Their jokes will just kill you!

Six comedians known for appearances on "The Howard Stern Show" will perform at 9 p.m. July 25 in The Orchards restaurant, Chambersburg.

Billed as "The Killers of Comedy — You'll Die Laughing," its line-up includes The Reverend Bob Levy, Sal "The Stockbroker" Governale, Brad Thacker, Shuli, Beetlejuice and Mike Morse.

"They play big theaters to comedy clubs, so to play a restaurant is a different venue for them," said Chris McMurry of Frederick, Md., who handles publicity for comedians and occasionally travels with them. "I'm a fan, too," he said.

The comedians take turns being on the road together, so performances vary, McMurry said. After Chambersburg, a group will go to Fort Myers, Fla., then San Francisco.

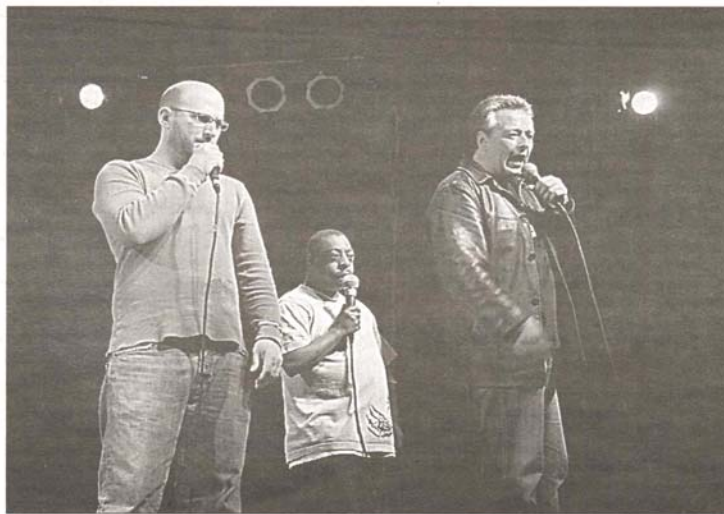
He said the comedians often mingle with showgoers — chatting, having photos taken or peddling merchandise. Scheduled to appear:

Beetlejuice (aka Lester Green) —

Recognized by his undersized head, oversized teeth and short stature, he has made Stern fans laugh for nearly 10 years through futile attempts to answer simple questions and repeat information presented to him no more than seconds earlier. He's perfected dwarf tossing, which involves full-sized folks throwing him through the air onto a mattress.

Sal the Stockbroker (Sal Governale) —

Having spent most of his 20s on Wall Street as a stockbroker, he longed to make a living with comedy. Stern hired the Long Island native to work full time on the show, where he makes phony phone calls and creates other packaged

The Reverend Bob Levy — Not a member of the clergy, he boasts an "irreverent" act. In 2002, the New Jersey resident won Stern's "World's Meanest Listener Contest." Levy organizes roasts of Stern show staff during its morning program on Sirius Satellite Radio. He is co-host (with Shuli) of "Miserable Men," a weekly program on Sirius that profiles the best horror stories of men's relationships with significant others.

Mike Morse — He interjects song parodies,

wacky props and a Mick Jagger imitation that could leave the Queen of England amused, according to his Web site. He's known for a comic tribute to classic TV show theme songs. Morse was a prize winner on ABC's "America's Funniest People."

Shuli — This one-name performer is a reporter for "Howard 100 News," a daily program that humorously covers Stern-related events. He's performed in Las Vegas and before moving east was co-writer and producer for the mockumentary about the life

expectancy of open mike comics titled "No Laughing Matter."

Brad Thacker — In 2000, the Indiana native born in 1980 received a degree in radio broadcasting, and since then has more than 200 comedy gigs under his belt. According to his Web site, his comedy influences include Stern, Richard Pryor, Bill Murray and Margaret Cho.
