The "Howard Stern Show" regulars drop stand-up acts Friday and Saturday at Circles Comedy Club, 300 W. Service Rd., Travis. The comedians take aim at sexless marriages, overbearing mother-in-laws and spineless men at 10 p.m. both nights.

Governale, a former Wall Street broker, got his comedy start in 1992 by torturing Stern's producer, Gary "Baba Booney" with prank calls. Levy's claim to fame is eating bleu cheese from women's buttocks. That bit has since been retired, but Levy promises the act will be just as brutal.

"We go out there and kill," he said. "It's almost like a rock concert."
